### ENROLLMENT OPTIONS AND SELECTION

Washington Administrative Code (WAC) section 39-121-182 establishes the requirements for all Alternative Learning Experience (ALE) programs in the state of Washington. Part time enrollment in an ALE program is allowed, per RCW 28A.150.350 when a student is:

- 1) Enrolled in a course of instruction in a private school and taking courses at and/or receiving ancillary services offered by any public school not available\* in such private school; or
- 2) Not enrolled in a private school and is receiving home-based instruction under RCW 28A.225.010, which instruction includes taking courses at or receiving ancillary services from the local school district or both; or
- 3) Involved in any work training program and taking courses in any public school, which work training program is approved by the school board of the district in which such school is located.
- 4) Students may also enroll part time in an ALE program if they are enrolled in another public school program for the balance of full time (1.0 FTE) enrollment. If the balance of their full time (1.0 FTE) enrollment is in a different school district than their ALE program enrollment, the two school districts **are required by law to execute a written agreement** that at minimum identifies the maximum aggregate basic education funding each district may claim for the duration of the agreement. This agreement must be effective **before** the non-resident district may claim funding for the student. A student's combined enrollment may not exceed full time (1.0 FTE).

**Prior to enrolling a non-resident student, OASIS must have a Choice Transfer request, submitted online by the student's district of residence, and a written agreement between districts for any shared public school enrollment. In all cases, parents must receive approval from all parties prior to any change to a student's enrollment percentage.**

A note on standardized tests: All students seeking a Washington State High School diploma must take and pass state standardized tests. OASIS will strictly enforce state assessment requirements. Students have the right to take these tests in their district of physical residence, or on the OASIS campus. OASIS staff is happy to assist in making your testing arrangements.
